- **Excellent Communication Skills:** Ability to effectively communicate various concepts to diverse audiences, including children, adults and fellow volunteers.
- Team Player: Willingness to work collaboratively with staff, volunteers and partners.
- Reliability: Three-hour consistent commitment per week for at least three months.
